

**JEHOVAH KANNA
aka God—part 5
Exodus 34:10-14**

Jehovah Kanna = The Lord is Jealous

Then the LORD said: "I am making a covenant with you. Before all your people I will do wonders never before done in any nation in all the world. The people you live among will see how awesome is the work that I, the LORD, will do for you. Obey what I command you today. I will drive out before you the Amorites, Canaanites, Hittites, Perizzites, Hivites and Jebusites. Be careful not to make a treaty with those who live in the land where you are going, or they will be a snare among you. Break down their altars, smash their sacred stones and cut down their Asherah poles. Do not worship any other god, for the LORD, whose name is Jealous, is a jealous God." Exodus 34:10-14 (NIV)

What does it mean that God is jealous?

- **Jealous ≠ insecure and suspicious**
- **Jealous ≠ bitter and revengeful**
- **Jealous = God's desire for our exclusive devotion to him.**

God is not mad at you; he's mad for you!
